What Lies Ahead—The Strategic Plan for 2025-2028

A team has been working on our Strategic Plan for over a year and the board approved the final draft on January 25. It has been an important process for the ministry, and we are grateful to everyone who contributed their input and time. It is a stronger plan because so many of you were involved.

The plan will help guide our efforts for the next three years in the following five areas: Community Outreach, Client & Patient Services, Development & Marketing, Staff & Volunteers, and Financial Stewardship.



Excerpt from the Strategic Plan Financial Report (page 6):

“Hope With Options’ financial performance over the past six years has been outstanding. Strong operating results have allowed for significant areas of growth, as well as maintaining a robust positive balance sheet and positioning us for future expansion. In spite of these results, we expect funding challenges in the coming years due to the rapidly rising costs of all resources, especially in staffing and technology. We expect the majority of our budgeted expenditures over the next three years to be funded from our faithful donors, special fundraising events, and grants. Executing our strategy around quality, efficiency, space, and information technology will require making investments in people, programs, and new technologies as we strive to respond to and predict the needs of our community. We put our entire trust in the providence of God as we follow His leading in order to achieve our vision, while remaining a financially solid non-profit organization.”

“We feel great responsibility to both our Lord and our donors to faithfully steward the funds placed in our trust for the achievement of our Mission. Therefore, adherence to an annual budget for continuing operations as well as a process for approval of new initiatives is important to us, as it will help us to achieve the wise and purpose-driven allocation of our financial resources.”

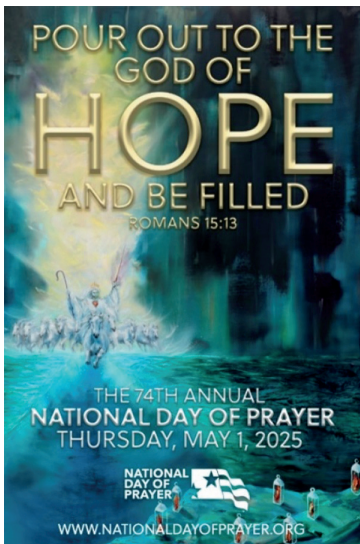
Healing the Heartbreak of Abortion: An 8-Session Bible Study

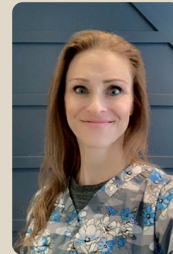
